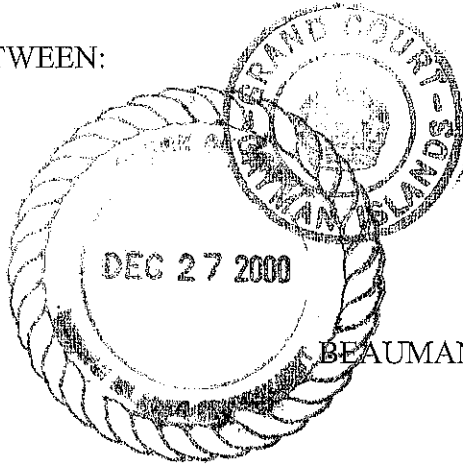

WRIT OF SUMMONS

To: Beauman International Ltd of PO Box 1800, West Wind Building, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

WITHIN 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO BOX 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

IF YOU FAIL to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement of Service within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ISSUED this 27th day of December 2000

NOTE: THIS WRIT may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by Order of the Court.

IMPORTANT

Directions for acknowledgement of service are given with the accompanying form.

The Plaintiff's claim is for a declaration that the following contractual clauses, that is:

1. Clause (6) of a Consulting Agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendant effective 1 May 1985; and
2. Clause (7) of an Administration Agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendant (by assignment by Beauman International (Ireland) Limited) effective 1 May 1985;

are unenforceable against the Plaintiff in whole or in part by reason of the fact that they are or include penalty clauses that are unenforceable as a matter of law.
