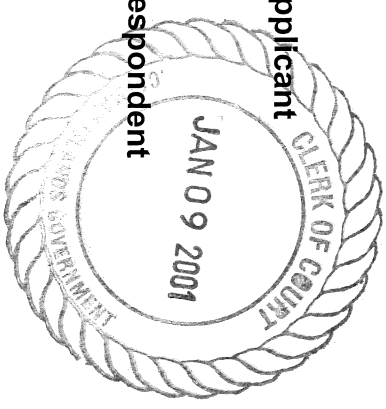

**EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS**




**LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED** attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the *26<sup>th</sup>* day of *January*, 2000 at 9:30 a.m. upon the hearing of an application on behalf of the Applicant, for the following orders and relief set out below.

1. An order that the Respondent do attend before a Judge of the Grand Court, on such date and at such time as the Court may direct, and be orally examined by the Court to determine whether the Respondent has any, and if so, what property or means of satisfying the order made by the Ontario Court (General Division) on May 6<sup>th</sup> 1996, and registered in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands on December 15<sup>th</sup> 2000, directing that the Respondent pay to the Applicant:
  - a) the sum of \$500.00 (Canadian) per month for the support of Aaron Lucas McFarlane, born November 6<sup>th</sup> 1987; and,
  - b) \$500.00 (Canadian) per month for the support of Ryan Neal McFarlane, born February 25<sup>th</sup> 1991,so long as each child is a minor and is enrolled in an educational programme on a full-time basis.

2. An order that the Respondent produce, at the time and place appointed for the examination, any books or documents in his possession relevant to the debts owing and property, if any, owned by him.
3. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just and equitable.
