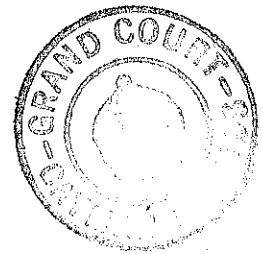

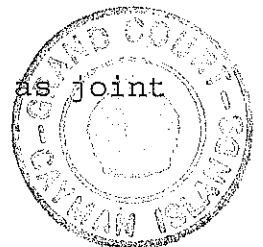
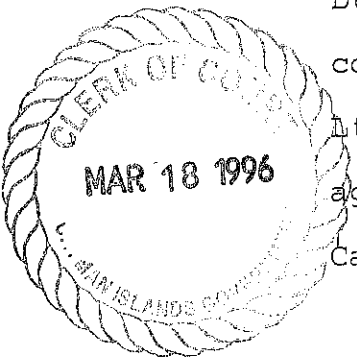

o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of Seestrasse 59, Portfach 530, 8703 Erlenbach, Zurich, Switzerland, for:

1. A declaration that the First and Second Defendants as partners in the Third Defendant are in a conflict of interest in acting as joint liquidators of Omni Securities Ltd.
2. Alternatively, a declaration that the First and Second Defendants as partners in the Third Defendant are in a conflict of interest as joint liquidators of Omni Securities Ltd in causing it to commence and prosecute the action against the Plaintiff and others in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands in Cause no. 104 of 1995.
3. An order removing the First and Second Defendants as joint liquidators of Omni Securities Ltd.
4. Alternatively, an order restraining the First and Second Defendants from continuing the conduct of the action against the Plaintiff and others in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands in Cause no. 104 of 1995.

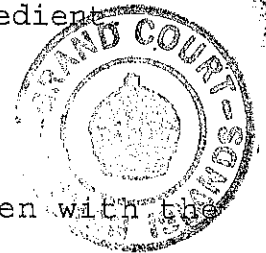
