

**EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Honourable Mr. Justice Graham in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town on 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2001 at 2:30 p.m. on the hearing of an application by Michael Wright, a person appointed by the Governor-in-Council pursuant to Section 13(i)(v) of the Banks & Trust Companies Law (2000 2<sup>nd</sup> Revision) ("the Controller") to assume control of the affairs of M.A. Bank Ltd. ("the Bank") for the following orders and directions.

1. Whether or not the Controller should carry on the business of the Bank;
2. Whether or not the Controller should suspend payment of deposit liabilities of the Bank;
3. Directions as to the nature and extent of the investigations to be conducted by the Controller.
4. Such further other directions as the Court thinks fit.
