

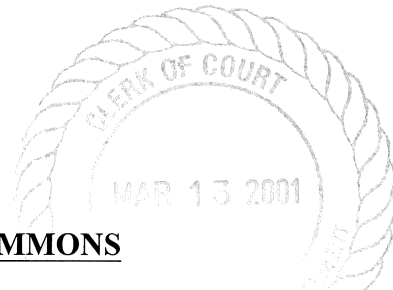




EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 13th day of March 2001, at nine o'clock in the forenoon on the hearing of an application *ex parte* by the Attorney General for the following orders:

1. That Guillermo Venegas Pintos, whether by himself, or by his servants, agents or otherwise howsoever until further order be restrained from transferring, assigning, withdrawing, removing from the jurisdiction or otherwise disposing of or dealing with any funds deposited or otherwise held in his names or to his order at Wiese Bank International or the Royal Bank of Canada Trust Company (Cayman) Limited (the "Banks").
2. Service of any order of the Court herein be effected on the person described in paragraph 1 hereof by effecting service of the order on the Banks.
3. Such further orders or directions as the Honourable Court shall deem fit.
