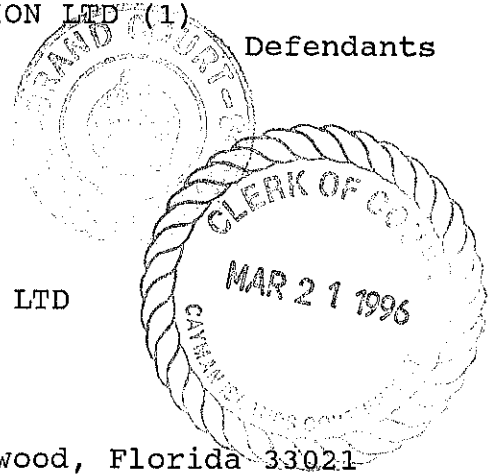

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

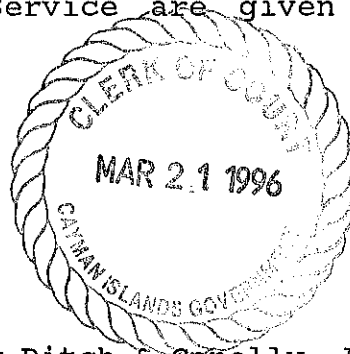
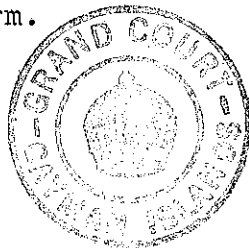
