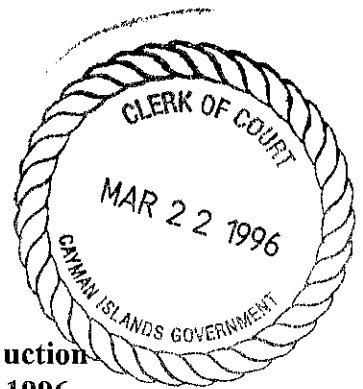

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 22 day of March 1996, at 2.30 o'clock, on the hearing of an application by the Applicant that

1. The sale of the property at PO Box 119 Northside, Grand Cayman is not to proceed until the matter of the Judicial Separation is determined.
2. Mrs. Ebanks be permitted to reside in the matrimonial home along with her four children.
3. All rental income from the apartments be paid to her so that she may forward it, along with an agreed amount of her salary, to the 2nd Respondent.
4. Subject to obtaining the Block and Parcel number of the property, an inhibition be placed on the Proprietorship Register until the matter of the Judicial Separation is determined.
