

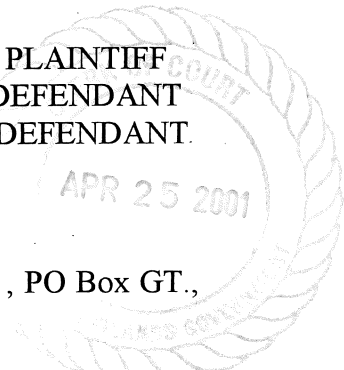
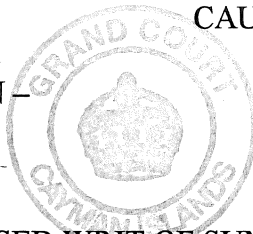

in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you
must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town,
Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether
you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or
if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the
proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered
against you forthwith without further notice.

date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. On 8 October 1999, the second defendant, the servant or agent of the first defendant, so negligently drove a motor vehicle, registration number 66 173, owned by the first defendant, along Shamrock Road, Pease Bay, Bodden Town, when at or near to the drive in theatre the second defendant collided with the Plaintiff's motor vehicle registration number 67 671.

PARTICULARS OF NEGLIGENCE

- (a) Driving at an excessive speed.
 - (b) Driving onto the wrong side of the road and there colliding with the Plaintiff.
 - (c) Failing to keep any or any proper look-out or to have any or any sufficient regard for any other traffic.
 - (d) Failing to stop, to slow down, to swerve, or in any other way so to manage or control the motor vehicle so as to avoid the collision.
1. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Plaintiff sustained personal injuries and has suffered loss and damage.

PARTICULARS OF INJURIES

The Defendant's date of birth is 21 March 1919. Following the accident on 8 October 1999, the Plaintiff was taken to George Town Hospital for treatment of an injury to his right ear and right side of his head.
