INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim against the Defendant is for CI\$6,235.16 including interest being the sum owed by the Defendant pursuant to an agreement made on or about 18th July, 1997 whereby the Defendant undertook to be liable for all moneys due to the Plaintiff in respect of services rendered to the Defendant within 30 days of the date of the invoice.

Notes on address for service

Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.

Indorsement by Plaintiff's attorney (or by Plaintiff is suing in person) of his name, address and reference, if any, in the box below.

Indorsement by Defendant's Attorney (or by Defendant if suing in person) of his name, address and reference, if any, in the box below.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Writ of Summons)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a *guardian ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

6. That after receipt of that letter the Defendant came in to the Plaintiff's attorneys-at-law offices on 17th April, 2000 and paid CI\$100.00 and arranged to pay CI\$100.00 per month.
7. That further on the 20th June, 2000 the Plaintiff's Attorneys-at-Law once again wrote to the Defendant for payment whereby the Defendant came into the said offices on 11th July, 2000 and paid CI\$100.00.
8. That on 7th August, 2000, the Plaintiff's Attorneys-at-Law wrote to the Defendant demanding payment however the Defendant has to date, not responded.
9. As at the 23rd May, 2001 the amount due and outstanding by the Defendant to the Plaintiff was CI\$6,235.16.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

1. The sum of CI\$6,235.16.
2. Pre-Judgment Interest thereon at the rate of 1 ½% per month calculated on a daily basis from 18th August, 1997 to the date of issue of the Writ being CI\$2,585.16.
3. Post-Judgment Interest thereafter pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision).
4. Costs.

STATEMENT REGARDING INTEREST:

- i. The rate of Pre-Judgment Interest claimed is 1 ½% per month calculated on a daily basis.
- ii. The date from which interest is calculated is the 18th August, 1997.
- iii. The interest accruing each day hereafter is CI\$1.92.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$6,235.160 (excluding fixed costs of CI\$500.00 and filing fees of CI\$150.00) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff.
