

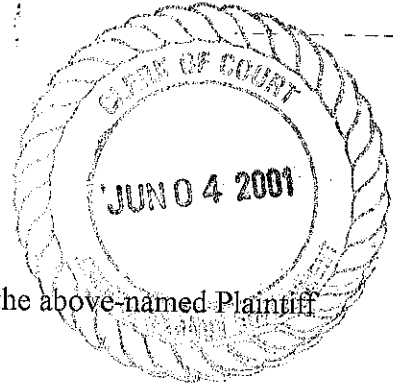
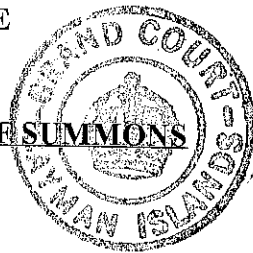

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 4th June, 2001.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff lives in West Bay, Grand Cayman.
2. The defendant lives in George Town..
3. On the 10th January, 2001, in consideration of the plaintiff withdrawing Cause No. 411 of 1999 against the defendant and Sandra Clarke, his wife, the defendant gave the plaintiff a promisory note to pay \$14,584.41 by monthly instalment of \$400.00 commencing on the 1st March, 2001.
4. Despite the promise the defendant has failed to pay June's instalment on time and the balance of \$13,384.41 is now due.
5. The Plaintiff is also entitled to interest being that established pursuant to the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) from the date of the issueanc of these proceedings.

AND the plaintiff claims:

1. The principal sum =\$13,384.41
2. Pre-judgement and post- judgement interest upon the said principal pursuant to the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules as prescribed from time to time; and
3. Costs as taxed or agreed.
