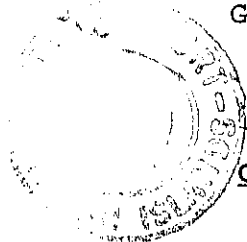

 of East End, Grand Cayman, B.W.I.

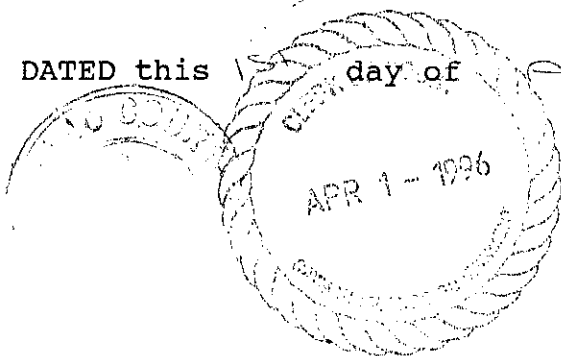
LET the Respondent attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, B.W.I. on the ²⁴ day of June 1996 at 9.30 o'clock in the fore/afternoon on the hearing of an application by the Applicant who seeks the determination of the Court on the following questions, namely an Order:-

1. That the Applicant be appointed guardian for the said George Davey Conolly ("the patient") and over his estate and effects with the following powers conferred upon him:
 - 1.1 to control and manage the property of the patient;
 - 1.2 to sell, exchange, charge or otherwise dispose of or deal with any property of the patient;

- 1.3 to invest the proceeds of sale or any other monies belonging to the patient in such securities as the Applicant for the time being is authorised by law to invest trust funds;
- 1.4 open and maintain a current account in any bank in the Cayman Islands and to deposit therein and/or withdraw therefrom such monies as may be necessary for the proper maintenance and care of the patient.
2. The Applicant shall keep proper accounts of his administration and management of the property of the patient and whenever required by the Court to do so shall file in Court copies of such accounts; the first such account covering the period of one year from the date of this Order is to be submitted within 1 month from the end of such period.
3. The cost of this application and the costs of the guardian incident and consequent upon the Order herein shall be paid from the estate and property of the patient.

AND LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of this Originating Summons, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.
