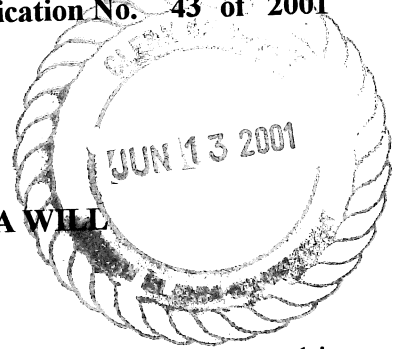

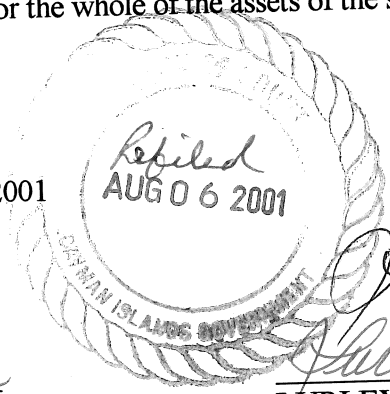

Box 122 Stake Bay, Cayman Brac, being the executor named in the last will of the late Victoria Eunice Scott, formerly of Cayman Brac, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced probate ~~and Julia Ann McLaughlin, having replaced Levi Everet Scott, being the named executor who is now deceased, as executor,~~ being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced probate, which said will was made at Cayman Brac and the said will, at the time of the death of the deceased, having been found lying at Cayman Brac in the custody of Lurley Scott, which said will, together with the certificate of death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a grant of probate of the said will to us and we enclose herewith our affidavits in that behalf and we undertake that in the event of such grant being made to us, we will -

- (a) within six months of the grant to us of probate of the said will we will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such grant to us we will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the will and the directions, if any, of the court and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
