

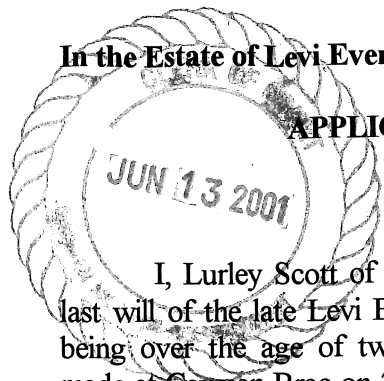

APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL
(Succession Law, section 3(7))



I, Lurley Scott of P.O. Box 122 Stake Bay, Cayman Brac, being the executor named in the last will of the late Levi Everet Scott formerly of Spot Bay, Cayman Brac, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced probate, which said will was made at Cayman Brac on 25 August, 1999 and the said will, at the time of the death of the deceased, having been found lying in the home of Lurley Scott in the custody of Lurley Scott which said will, together with the certificate of death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a grant of probate of the said will to me and I enclose herewith my affidavit in that behalf and I undertake that in the event of such grant being made to me, I will -

- (a) within six months of the grant to me of probate of the said will I will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such grant to me I will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the will and the directions, if any, of the court and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
