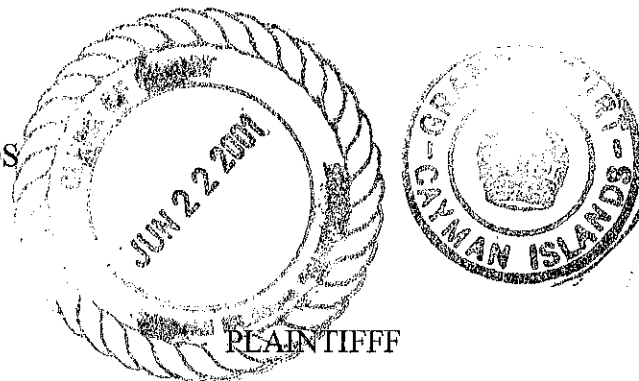

WRIT OF SUMMONS

To: (1) Annice Smith – Smith Road

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above named Plaintiff in respect of claim set out in the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days of service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE: This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, within 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by the order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. On the 23rd July, 2000 at about 12:35 am the plaintiff was driving her Toyota passenger motor bus, registration no. 45916 along the West Bay Road, when on reaching the vicinity of Island Pine, she was involved in a collision with a Toyota Corona motor car, Registration No. 46878, owned by the (1) defendant and driven by her servant or agent, the (2) defendant on the said road. The plaintiff was born on the 22nd October, 1951.
2. The said collision was caused by the negligence of the (2) defendant as servant or agent of the (1) defendant.

PARTICULARS OF NEGLIGENCE

1. Driving too fast in the circumstances
2. Switching from the left lane to the centre lane when it was unsafe to do so.
3. Failing to observe the plaintiff's stationary vehicle.
4. The (2) defendant was found guilty of careless driving on the 24th October, 2000 as a result of the said collision and the plaintiff will rely on the said conviction as proof of the negligence of the (2) defendant.
5. By reason of the said collision, the plaintiff has sustained injuries and has suffered loss and damage.

- a. Abrasion to the right knee
- b. Injury to the neck (whiplash)
