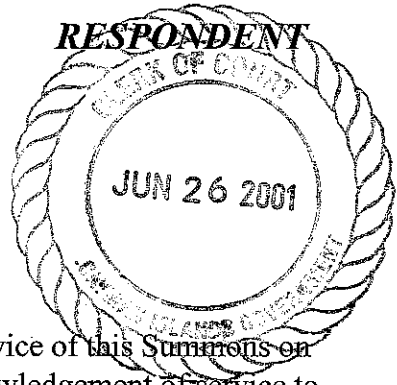

1. I am the husband of Celia Maria Hydes, who I married on 5<sup>th</sup> October 1996.
2. Prior to our marriage Celia and I had a child, Tracy Teresa Hydes, born 17 June 1995.
3. Celia had a child already born on 29<sup>th</sup> November 1992, the child's name is Cindy Margarita Castro. In July 1996, Tomy Castro, Cindy's father, died in the Dominican Republic. Cindy is my wife's first child. In September 1996 the arrangements had been made and Cindy travelled to Cayman and commenced to live with Celia and I.

4. I treat Cindy as my own child, and I seek an Order that my wife and I have joint custody of Cindy, so that decisions and arrangements regarding her future can be made by both my wife and I. I have discussed this with Celia, the child's mother, and she fully supports my application.

1. I am the mother of Cindy Margarita Castro who was born on the 29<sup>th</sup> November, 1992 in the Dominican Republic.
2. The child's father was TOMY CASTRO who died in July of 1996.
3. Cindy was still in the Dominican Republic when I met and agreed to marry Troy Donahue Hydes. The arrangements were for a wedding in October, 1996. As can be seen from above, the child's father died before that date.
4. Following her father's death, Cindy came to Cayman in September 1996 and has lived with Troy and myself here in Cayman since that time.
5. I married Troy Donahue Hydes on the 5<sup>th</sup> October, 1996 and Cindy has continued to live with us. My husband treats Cindy as his own child and wishes to regularise his relationship with the child.


6. My husband and I have one child of our own, Tracy Teresa Hydes, date of birth: 17 June 1995, that child has Cayman status.
