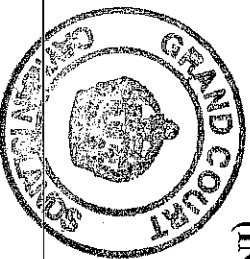

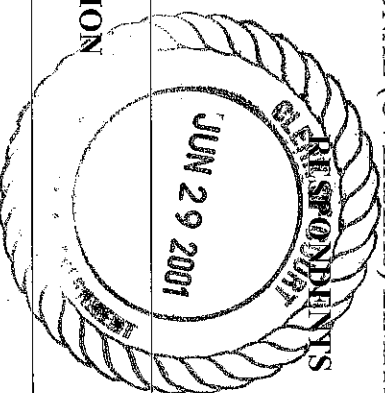


ORIGINATING APPLICATION



Let all Parties concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 5 day of Sept. 2001 at 9:30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by M.S. Bhatti and Sons Inc. and Libpak Inc. both of P O Box 1834, Monrovia, Liberia, claiming to be creditors of the Bank of Credit and Commerce International (Overseas) Limited (In Liquidation) for an order that the decision of the Respondents contained in their letters dated 9<sup>th</sup> November 2000 rejecting their proofs of debt in the liquidation of the above named company for the sum of US\$135,860.00 and US\$85,000.00 respectively may be reversed, and the proofs be ordered to be admitted in full. The time limit from the filing of this
