Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledge of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

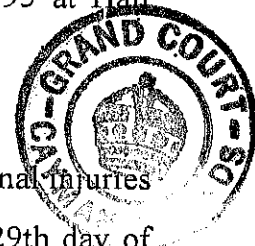

ENDORSEMENT

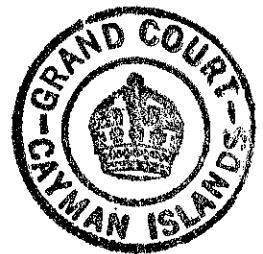
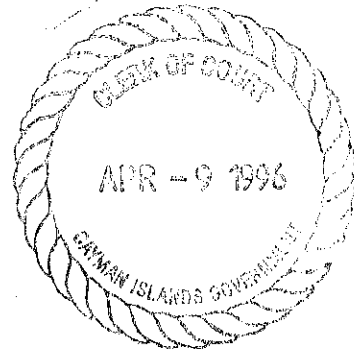
AND the Plaintiff claims:-
