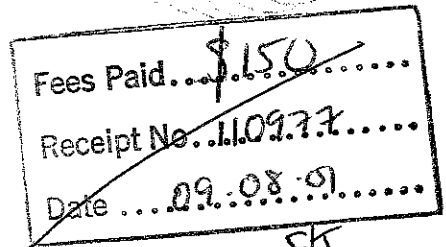
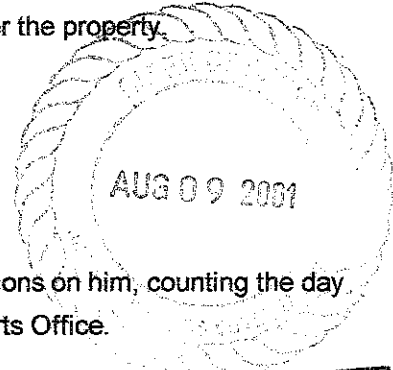
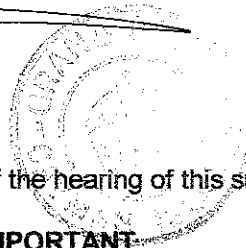

1. That this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the sale by Private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Registry with absolute title and being particularly known as Parcel 390 of Block 14E in the George Town South Registration Section of Grand Cayman ("the property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the property.
2. That the reserve price for the property be CI\$135,000.00.
3. That the Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this application.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within fourteen days after service of this summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.

OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, an originating summons served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as HYACINTH HUE."
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (".....") after his/her name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS/HER OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (....." after his/her name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Notes on address for service

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
