

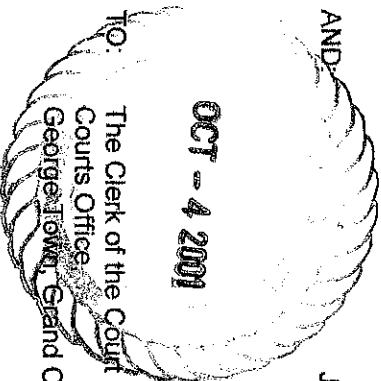

That this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the sale by Private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Registry with absolute title and being particularly known as Parcel 67 of Block 75A in the East End Registration Section of Grand Cayman ("the property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the property.
2. That the reserve price for the property be C\$160,000.00.
3. That the Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this application.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within fourteen days after service of this summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
