THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

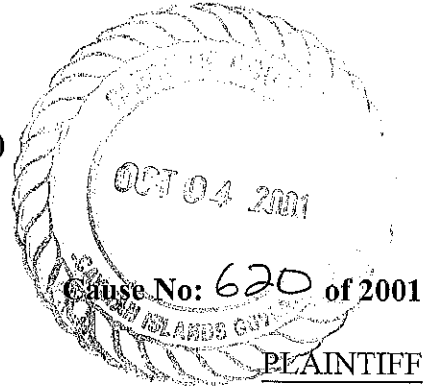
If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 4th of October, 2001

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff claims CI\$41159.15 from the Defendants for an Overseas Medical debt
2. Margaret Branch received medical treatment from the Baptist Hospital of Miami on October 27th and 28th, December 3rd and November 4th of 1998.
3. The cost of this medical treatment amounted to 41,159.15 and it was paid by the Cayman Islands Government.
4. On 21st October 1998 the Defendants signed a Promissory Note agreeing to repay the Cayman Islands Government for all medical expenses paid by the Government on behalf of Ms. Branch.
5. The Health Services Department wrote to the Defendants requesting payment.
6. The Treasury Debt Collector wrote to the Defendants on 13th September, 2001 requesting payment but this debt remains unpaid.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sum of CI\$41159.15.
2. Interest at the statutory rate of 6 ¼%
2. Fixed cost of CI\$250.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff.
