

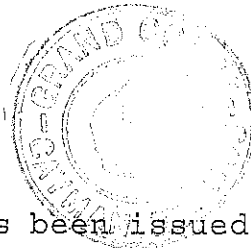

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ of Summons on you, counting the days of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 15th day of APRIL 1996.

NOTE:- This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by Order of the Court.

SPECIAL ENDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim is for the sum of CI\$5,029.59 being the overdue balance on account in respect of goods sold and delivered by the Plaintiff to the Defendant between July and September 1994 pursuant to a signed credit agreement entered into between the Plaintiff and the Defendant dated 22nd July, 1994.

PARTICULARS

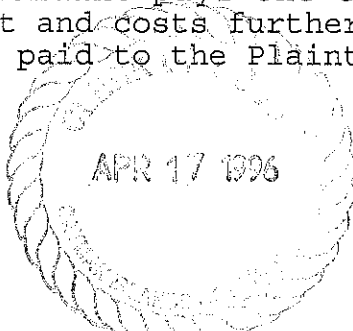
1. The Plaintiff is a wholesaler and retailer licensed to carry on business in the Cayman Islands, having its office and principal place of business situate at Crewe Road, George Town, Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendant is a person legally resident in the Cayman Islands, whose address for service is P.O. Box 215, West Bay, Grand Cayman. She was formerly, the owner and operator of "Solie's Bar" which is situated in the district of West Bay.
3. On or about 22nd July, 1994 the Plaintiff extended a credit facility to the Defendant in respect of goods to be sold and delivered to the Defendant's then establishment "Solie's Bar".
4. The Plaintiff agreed to provide the said facility in consideration of which the Defendant agreed, inter alia, to pay to the Plaintiff the amount of any and all purchases charged to her account not later than 15 days after the Plaintiff's statement of account was delivered.
5. The Defendant also agreed to pay interest at the rate of 1 1/2% per month (calculated on a daily basis) on any amount outstanding for more than one month from the prior billing

- date and thereafter on all amounts in arrears until paid.
6. By a series of invoices dated 28th July, 2nd August, 3rd August, 15th August and 1st September, 1994 the Plaintiff sold and delivered to the Defendant, beer, juices and soft drinks to the value of CI\$5,029.59.
 7. Despite numerous demands made by the plaintiff and the Plaintiff's attorneys the Defendant has failed to pay to the Plaintiff the balance due in respect of the said goods together with interest thereon.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

1. The sum of CI\$5,029.59;
2. Interest pursuant to credit agreement dated 22nd July, 1994 of 1 1/2% per month from 11th August, 1994 until satisfaction of debt. Total interest claim therefrom to date being CI\$1508.89 ie.e. CI\$75.44 per month for 20 months.
3. Interest thereon pursuant to Section 62 (1) of the Judicature Law at the rate of 7 3/8 % per annum from the date of judgment until satisfaction.
4. Fixed costs pursuant to Order 62 Rule 1 (b) of the Grand Court Rules, 1995 of CI\$250.00 plus costs of filing this Writ of CI\$115.00.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of \$6,903.48 plus interest and costs further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his attorney.

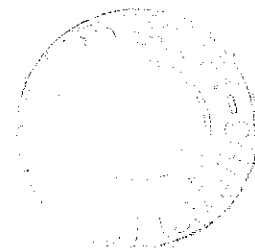

Notes on address for service

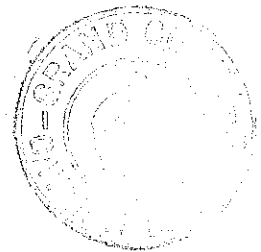
Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is tread as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Writ of Summons)".
4. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
