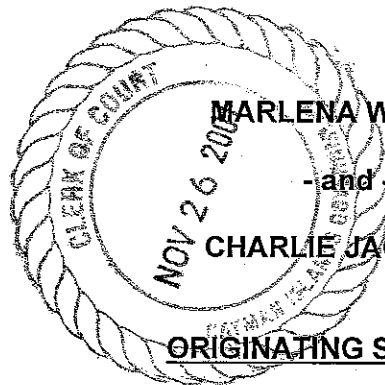

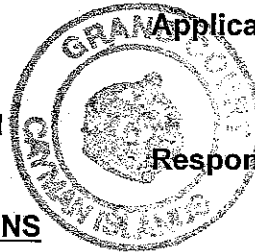

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 9 day of JAN 2002-2001, at 9:30 am/pm upon the hearing of an application by the Applicant, Alicia Solomon, for the following orders and relief set out below.

1. The removal to the Grand Court for enforcement and directions of the order made by the Magistrate on 14 July, 1989 whereby the respondent was ordered to pay maintenance of \$25.00 per week for the children Robert Brenly Jackson born on the 11 August, 1983 and Monica Transito Jackson born on the 10 June, 1985. The respondent has failed to pay maintenance for the two children in spite of several commitment to prison, first on 6 October 1989 and the second time on the 16 March, 1990, and the third time on the 10 September, 1993. He has been reluctant to pay any monies toward the maintenance for the other children, for which at the moment I am not applying for it. I am now suing for the amount of \$13,200.00 for Robert and Monica Jackson.
2. All further proceedings in the Summary Court in SC Maintenance # 29/89 be stayed.
3. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just and equitable.

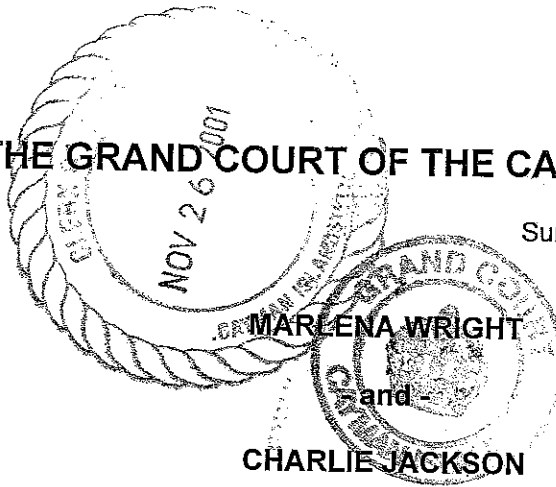

AFFIDAVIT

I, Marlena Wright of George Town, Cayman Islands make oath and say as follows:

1. I am the applicant in this matter and have personal knowledge of the matters herein save where stated to be upon information and belief.
2. On 14 July, 1989 the Summary Court made an affiliation order adjudging the Respondent, Charlie Jackson to be the putative father of my two children Robert Brenley Jackson born on 11 August, 1983 and Monica Transito Jackson born on the 10 June, 1985.
3. On the Summary Court also ordered that the respondent pay \$25 per week on 14 July, 1989; sad to say this amount was never increase, Mr Jackson has paid only \$150 since 1995, **no more monies has been paid** towards the maintenance of these children. The respondent has failed to pay maintenance for the two children in spite of several commitment to prison, first on 6 October 1989 and the second time on 16 March, 1990 and the third time on the 10 September, 1993. He has been reluctant to pay any monies toward the maintenance for the two other children, for which at the moment I am not applying for it. **I am now suing for the amount of \$13,200.00 for Robert and Monica Jackson only.**
4. I make this affidavit in support of an application for directions or for such other relief as this Honourable Court may order.
