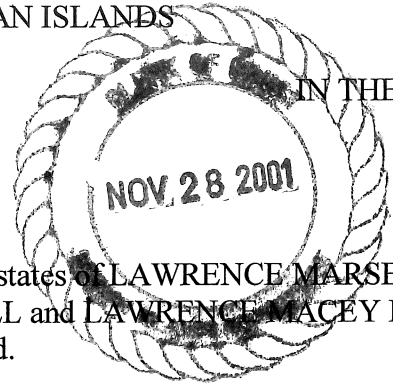

Succession Law

I, WILLIAM JACKSON of P. O. Box 325, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, being the surviving executor named in the Last Will and Testament of the late Lawrence Marsey Powell (aka Lawrence Macy Powell and Lawrence Macey Powell) and Mavis Virginia Powell, formerly of Bodden Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, surviving the deceased, being over the age of eighteen years and not having renounced probate, which said will was made at Bodden Town, Grand Cayman on the 13th day of October, 1982 and the said will, at the time of the death of the deceased, having been found lying at Bodden Town, Grand Cayman in the home of the deceased, which said will, together with the certificate of death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a grant of probate of the said will to me and I enclose herewith my affidavit in that behalf and I undertake that in the event of such grant being made to me, I will –

- a) within six months of the grant to me of the probate of the said will I will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- b) within one year of such grant to me, I will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the will and the directions, if any, of the courts and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
