




LET THE DEFENDANTS, within fourteen days after service of this summons on their
attorneys-at-law, counting the day of service return the accompanying acknowledgment of
service to the Court's Office, P. O. Box 495 G, Grand Cayman.

By this summons which is issued on the application of Benson O. Ebanks and O. Graham Ebanks the Plaintiffs seek the following relief:

1. The modification upon such terms as this Court deems appropriate of a pedestrian right of way ("the Pedestrian Right of Way") across Parcel 84 REM 1 of Block 5C of the West Bay registration section ("the Property") on the grounds that unless modified the Pedestrian Right of Way will impede the Plaintiffs' ability to sell the Property and that the proposed modification will not injure any person entitled to the benefit of the Pedestrian Right of Way.
2. Such other order as this court deems appropriate.
3. That provision be made for the cost of this application.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.
