
EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Chief Justice in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 19 day of December, 2001 at 10 o'clock in the fore noon on the hearing of an application pursuant to Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) by the Joint Liquidators of Euro Bank Corporation (in Liquidation) (the "Bank") of Cardinal Plaza, PO Box 1792GT, George Town, Grand Cayman that directions be given as to whether evidence referred to herein shall be given and, if so, the terms upon which such evidence shall be given.

The Applicants intend to give evidence in the form of disclosure of original documents and other materials to the RCIP, the FRU and their legal advisors in the proceedings R. v. Burges et al. Ind. No 6 of 2000 proceeding in the Grand Court. On 30th November, 2001 the Grand Court of its own motion made an Order in the Bank's winding up proceedings (Cause No 379 of 1999) that the Applicants disclose to the Crown the materials set out in the Schedule attached to that Order (the "Material") for use in the trial of those proceedings or for disclosure to each of the Defendants as unused material. The Material contains confidential information, including, but not limited to: the identity of accountholders; the identity of beneficial owners of accountholders; the addresses of accountholders; their account numbers; and transfers into and out of their accounts. The said confidential information relates to

customers of the Bank which is in the possession of the Bank either by reason of a banking relationship or of the Bank or its subsidiaries acting as trustee of certain trusts or providing managed company services.
