ORIGINATING SUMMONS

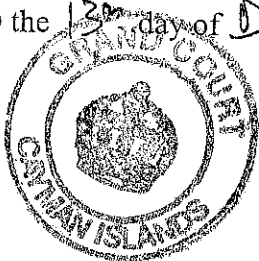
LET THE DEFENDANTS attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the ²⁵ day of ^{MARCH}, 2001² at ^{9:30} a.m./p.m. on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for the following orders:

1. That this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the sale by Private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Register with absolute title and being particularly known as Registration Section West Bay North West Block 4D Parcel 193 ("the Property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the Property.
2. That the Defendants and any other person occupying the Property do, within 28 days of this Order, vacate the Property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the Property.
3. That the Plaintiff do have leave to issue a Writ of Possession in relation to the Property at the expiry of the 28 days referred to in paragraph 2 above.
4. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days of service upon them of this summons, including the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.
