

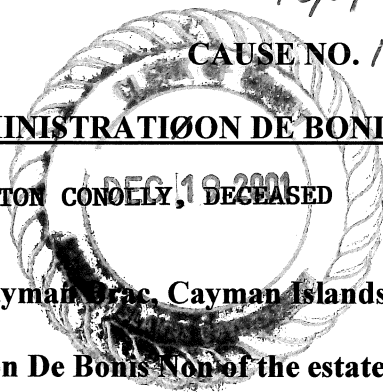

APPLICATION FOR LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION DE BONIS NON

I HINTON R. CONOLLY of the Creek, Cayman, Grand Cayman Islands hereby apply for Grant of Letters of Administration De Bonis Non of the estate of the late James Dighton Conolly, deceased of East End, Grand Cayman who died on or about the 7<sup>th</sup> of April 1891, intestate, and to whose estate on the 24<sup>th</sup> of January, 1976, Letters of Administration of all the estate which by law devolves on and vests in the personal representative of the said deceased was committed and granted to Ivy Ianthie Ebanks, lawful granddaughter of the deceased by the Grand Court of The Cayman Islands on 24<sup>th</sup> January 1976 which grant now remains on record, who after intermeddling in the estate and effects died on or about the 2nd of April 1993, leaving part thereof unadministered.

And I annexe hereto my affidavit in support of my application, the certificate of death of the said James Dighton Conolly and a copy of the certificate of death for the late Ivy Ianthie Ebanks.





And I declare myself bound unto the Financial Secretary of the islands in the sum of CI \$195,000.
