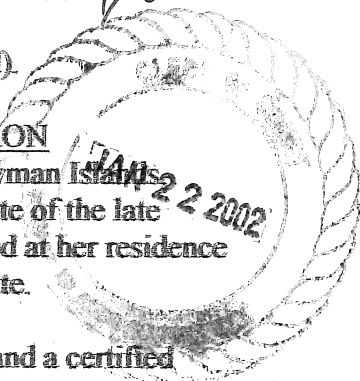

AND I annex hereto an affidavit in support of my application and a certified copy of the death certificate of the late LYNETT INEZ STEWART.

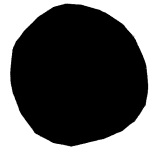
