

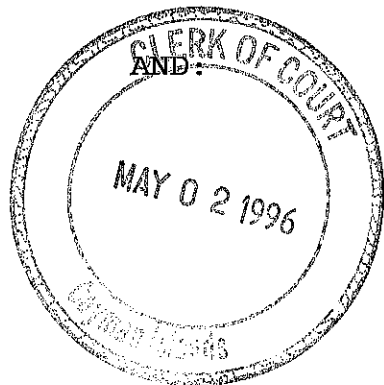

EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

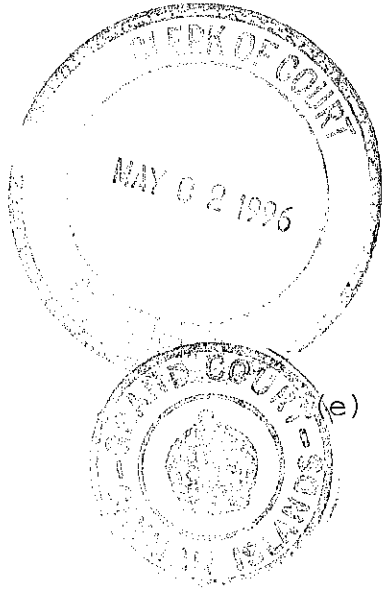
LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge of the Grand Court in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman at a.m./p.m. on the 7th day of May, 1996 on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for an order that:-

1. The Defendant shall, within 21 days after service of the Order sought herein (or by such other time and date as may be agreed to in writing by the Plaintiff) provide to the Plaintiff's attorneys-at-law true copies of all documents or records (including documents and records that are stored electronically by means of computer or on computer hard or other disc or otherwise) that are in the possession, custody or power of the Defendant relating to:-

- (a) the legal and beneficial ownership of and control over the issued and authorised share capital in an exempt company registered in the Cayman Islands (now struck from the register) known as Brokerage Trading and Financing Services ("BTFS") including, without prejudice to the foregoing, any nominee agreements or

shareholder agreements.

- (b) shareholders of BTFS and all other persons who have at any time been authorised to give instructions on their behalf or have purported to do so or have in fact done so and all instructions given by and all correspondence or communications involving such shareholders or other persons;
- (c) the opening and operation of bank and other accounts in the name of BTFS with the Grand Cayman Branch of Morgan Grenfell (CI) Ltd. and/or with Morgan Grenfell (Cayman) Limited (the "BTFS Account") and all dealings therewith.
- (d) the opening and operation of any other bank or other accounts and all dealings therewith, established or held in the sole name of BTFS or jointly held with any other person or persons or held by nominees on its or their behalf or on behalf of either of them or any accounts in respect of which BTFS is an authorised signatory (and for the avoidance of any doubt "any account" includes any deposit account).
- (e) any other assets held or formerly held by BTFS, either in its sole name or jointly with any other person or persons whether on its or their behalf or held by nominees on its or their behalf or on behalf of either of them.
- (f) the opening and operation of any bank accounts or other accounts and all dealings therewith, in the name of the individuals or entities referred to in the Schedule A attached hereto, marked "A" ("Schedule A") or any of them or in respect of which the individuals or entities



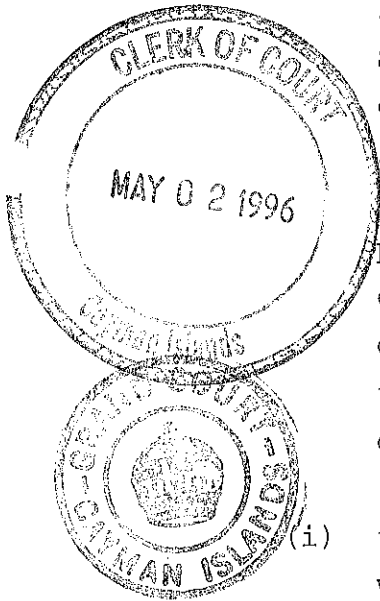
or any of them are reputed owners or are authorised signatories or are authorised to give instructions or have given instructions or are giving instructions.

(g) any other assets held or formally held by any of the individuals or entities referred to in Schedule A hereto or any of them, whether in their sole name or jointly with any other person or persons whether on his, her, its or their behalf or held by nominees on his, her or its behalf or any of them. (and for the avoidance of any doubt "other assets" includes an interest in any fixed or discretionary trust).

(h) all correspondence or communications between or involving the persons or entities referred to in Schedule A hereto or any of them or any person or entity authorised to give or who has at anytime given instructions relating to BTFS or to the BTFS Account or any other accounts or other assets referred to in subparagraphs (c) to (g) above inclusive or any person or entity whose name is referred to in any of the documents or records referred to in this paragraph of this Order or any person or entity who has signed such documents and all notes or records of the same.

(i) the officers or agents of BTFS and all other persons who have at any time been authorized to give instructions on its behalf or in relation to its affairs or have purported to do so or have in fact done so and all instructions given by and all correspondence involving such officers, agents or other persons.

(j) the promotion, formation, business, dealings, affairs or property of BTFS.



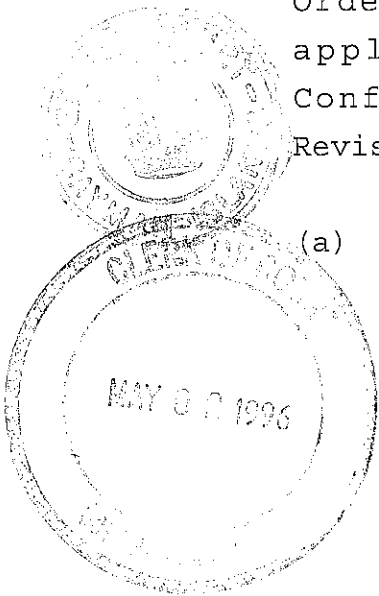
Provided that paragraph 1(a) and 1(j) inclusive of this Order, shall extend, so far as the individuals and entities listed in Part 2 of Schedule A are concerned, only to documents and records which are or appear to be or are believed by the Defendant to be connected with, to concern or to relate to the Plaintiff or the persons or entities listed in Part 1 of Schedule A.

2. The Defendant be restrained until paragraph 1 of the Order has been complied with or further order in the meantime (whether by itself, its directors, officers, servants or agents or any of them or otherwise howsoever) without the written consent of the Plaintiff from doing the following acts or any of them that is to say parting with possession of or destroying or mutilating or amending or deleting or removing or disposing of any of the documents or records referred to in paragraph 1 above.

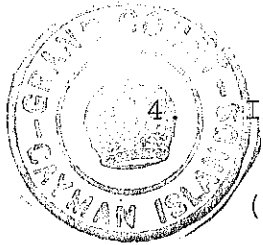
3. If the Defendant is of the opinion that paragraph 1 of the Order sought imposes upon it an obligation to make an application for directions under Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision), it shall:

(a) within 7 days after service of this Order:-

- (i) issue an ex parte originating summons;
- (ii) swear and file an affidavit in support of its application;
- (iii) serve the ex parte originating summons upon the Attorney General;



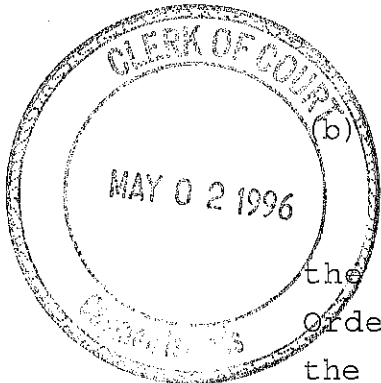
- (iv) use its best endeavours to list its originating summons for hearing prior to the expiry of the period specified in paragraph 1 of this Order;
 - (v) notify the Plaintiff's attorneys of the date upon which the ex parte originating summons was issued and the date upon which it will be heard; and
- (b) within 2 days after the hearing of the ex parte originating summons serve a copy of the Order upon the Plaintiff.



4. In the event that:-

- (a) the Defendant makes an application under Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision); and
- (b) complies with the requirements of paragraph 5 of this Order

the Defendant's time for complying with paragraph 1 of this Order shall be abridged or extended to expire 2 days after the hearing of the ex parte originating summons.

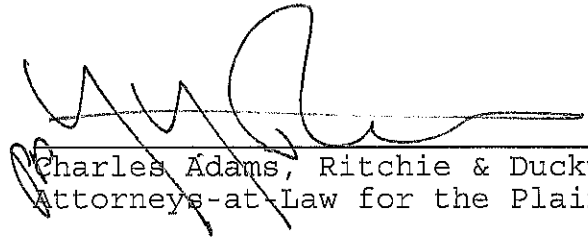


5. The Defendant shall have liberty to apply to vary or discharge this Order upon giving not less than 3 days prior notice to the Plaintiff.
6. Such further or other directions as this Honourable Court thinks fit.
7. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court

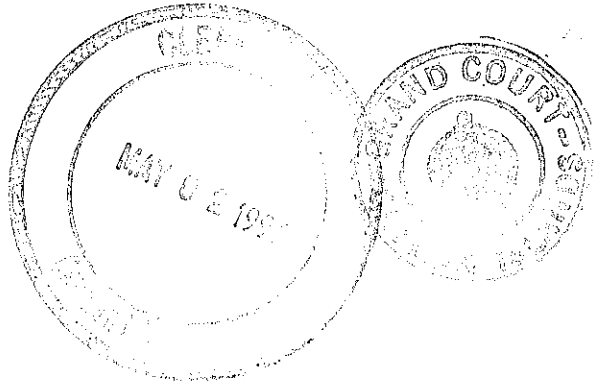
thinks fit.

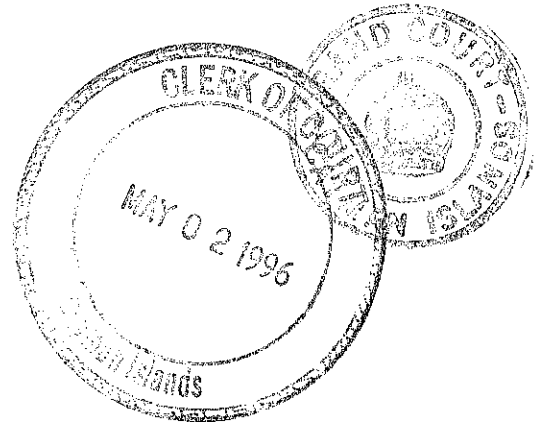
TIME ESTIMATE: The estimated length of the hearing of this originating summons is 2 hours.
