LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 21st day of march, 2002 at 9:30 o'clock in the noon on the hearing of an application pursuant to Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law (1995 Revision) by the Joint Liquidators of Euro Bank Corporation (in Liquidation) (the "Bank") of Cardinal Plaza, PO Box 1792GT, George Town, Grand Cayman that directions be given as to whether evidence referred to herein shall be given and, if so, the terms upon which such evidence shall be given.


The Applicants are requested to give evidence in the form of disclosure of original documents and other materials to the Provincial Court of Alberta (the "Alberta Court") for use in the proceedings R. v. Viccars et al. proceeding in the Alberta Court. On 7th January, 2001 the Grand Court made an Order on the application of the Attorney-General to assist the Alberta Court pursuant to the Evidence (Proceedings in Other Jurisdictions) (Cayman Islands) Order (Cause No 815 of 2001) that the Applicants disclose to the Alberta Court the following materials as set out in that Order for use in the trial of those proceedings: (the "Material"):

1. records relating to the accounts of the following entities and persons:
 - a. Thomas Viccars
 - b. James Yelle
 - c. Margaret Norman
 - d. Marie Lynne Craig
 - e. S.R.O. Partnership
 - f. Sanders - Lake Marketing Limited
 - g. S.R.O. International Inc.
 - h. 636203 Alberta Ltd.

2. The records referred to in paragraph 1 above to the following matters:
 - a. The details of the account records in the names listed in paragraph 2 a to h, herein from date of account opening to closure;
 - b. The identity of the person or persons under whose authority the said bank accounts were opened;
 - c. The identification of the beneficial ownership of each of the said accounts;
 - d. Details of the flow of funds from the partners of S.R.O. Partnership to Sanders - Lake Marketing Limited or S.R.O. International Inc. which were used to pay three promissory notes dated 14/1/94;
 - e. Details of the flow of funds into and from the bank accounts of Sanders - Lake Marketing Limited, S.R.O. International Inc. and 636203 Alberta Ltd.; and
 - f. Information as to the beneficial ownership of 636203 Alberta Ltd. In particular during the years 1994 and 1995.

The Material contains confidential information, including, but not limited to: the identity of beneficial owners of accountholders; the addresses of accountholders; their account numbers; and transfers into and out of their accounts. The said confidential information relates to accountholders of the Bank which is in the possession of the Bank either by reason of a banking relationship or of the Bank or its subsidiaries providing managed company services.
