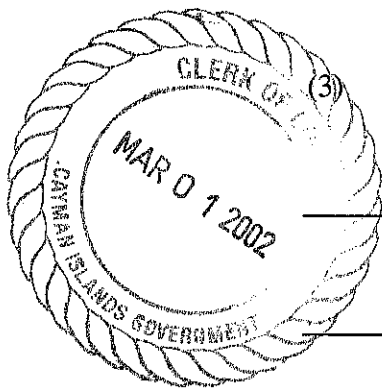

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET THE PARTIES attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the _____ day of _____, 2002 at _____ in the _____ noon for the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff for:

1. A declaration that the deemed dissolution of Beacon Finance Company Ltd. on 1st August 1995 is void.
2. An order that the Plaintiff be re-appointed as the Liquidator of Beacon Finance Company Ltd.
3. Alternatively to paragraph 2 above, a declaration that the Plaintiff continues to be the Liquidator of Beacon Finance Company Ltd. by virtue of her appointment on 9th December 1994.
4. A declaration that the land known as the land situate near Barnes Lodge, Hemel Hempstead Road, Kings Langley Hertfordshire, England and the land situate at Shelley Hill in the Parish of Leighton Buzzard in the County of Bedfordshire, England (the

"Land") is vested in Beacon Finance Company Ltd. , alternatively, in the Plaintiff as Liquidator of Beacon Finance Company Ltd.

5. An order that Beacon Finance Company Ltd. be restored forthwith to the Companies Register.
6. Alternatively to paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 5 above, a declaration that the Plaintiff is empowered to sign such documentation and carry out all incidental acts as would permit the transfer of (the "Land") to a third party in accordance with the intended scheme of the liquidation.
7. Further or other relief.
8. Provision for costs.

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within 14 days after service of this summons on them counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.

Notes:

- (1) This Summons may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the above date unless renewed by order of the Court.
- (2) If a Defendant does not attend personally or by his attorney at the time and place above mentioned such order will be made as the Court may think just and expedient.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Party or by the Party if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Party (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 28 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Party personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Party is referred to in the Originating Summons in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "referred to as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Party is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Party is an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Party is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Party is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Party acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
