

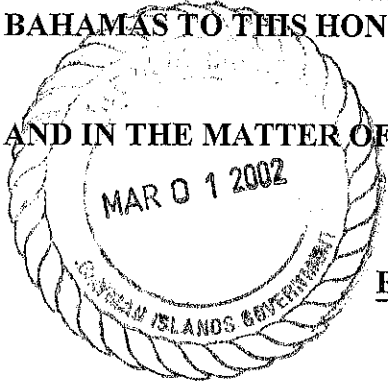



**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** pursuant to section 156 of the Bankruptcy Law (1997 Revision) and/or pursuant to this Court's inherent jurisdiction that:

1. The appointment of G. Clifford Culmer, as Trustee in Bankruptcy ("the Trustee in Bankruptcy") of the Property of Sheikh Fahad, be recognised in this jurisdiction.

2. The Trustee in Bankruptcy be granted all general law powers and the statutory powers accorded to a trustee in bankruptcy in this jurisdiction and in particular, that he be granted the powers under Section 107 of the Bankruptcy Law (1997 Revision).
3. The Trustee in Bankruptcy be granted all other and additional powers of relief against the Property of the bankrupt, Sheikh Fahad, as this Honourable Court deems just.
4. There be no order as to costs.
5. There be liberty to apply.
