
APPLICATION FOR GRANT OF
PROBATE OF A WILL



I, Jennifer Woolfall (formerly Finlay) being the Executrix named in the last Will of the late Jean Julia Isabel Jackson, formerly of Savannah, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, surviving the deceased, being over the age of 21 years and not having renounced probate, which said Will was made at George Town, Grand Cayman on the 1st day of November 1999 and the said Will, at the time of the death of the deceased, having been found lying in a safe located at the residence of the deceased at Shamrock Drive, Savannah, Grand Cayman which said Will together with the Certificate of Death annexed hereto, hereby apply for a Grant of Probate of the said Will to me and I enclose herewith my Affidavit in that behalf and I undertake that in the event of such grant being made to me, I will:

- (a) within 6 months of the grant to me of Probate of the said Will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within 1 year of such grant to me administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and the directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the estates of the said estate.
