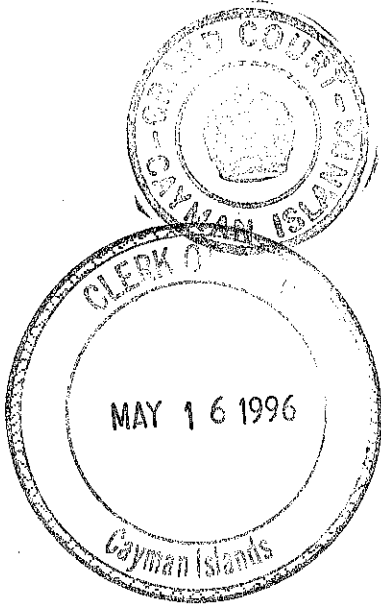

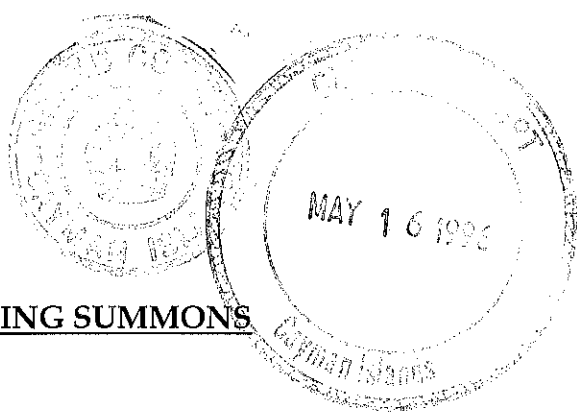

EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers, at the Law Court, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the day of 1996 at a.m./p.m. on the hearing of an application on behalf of Judge Jose Benquis Camhi, Minister of the Court of Appeal of Santiago, Visiting Minister in the Fifth Criminal Court of Santiago, Republic of Chile, dated the 31st January 1996 for an Order that:-

1. The Clerk of the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands or such other person as this Honourable Court may think fit be appointed Examiner to take down or cause to be taken down in writing or in the form of a sworn Affidavit the evidence of a proper officer of the Grand Cayman branch of Morgan Grenfell (CI) Ltd. of Elizabethan Square, PO Box 1984, George Town, Grand Cayman, who is resident within your jurisdiction, pursuant to the provisions of the Evidence (Proceedings in other Jurisdictions) (Cayman Islands) Order 1978.
2. That the proper officer ("the witness") of the Grand Cayman branch of Morgan Grenfell (CI) Ltd. or his successor, be compelled to attend before the said Examiner herein at the offices of Quin & Hampson of Harbour Centre, Third Floor, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the appointed day or such other day(s) and time(s) as the said Examiner may appoint and that the said proper officer be examined upon oath or affirmation touching the testimony so required by Judge Jose Benquis Camhi, Minister of the Court of Appeal of Santiago, Visiting Minister in the Fifth Criminal Court of Santiago, Republic of Chile pursuant to

the Letter of Request dated the 31st January 1996 or alternatively; that the witness attend before the Clerk of the Grand Court and swear an Affidavit containing the evidence required by Judge Jose Benquis Camhi with the attached exhibits before the Clerk of the Grand Court.


3. That the said proper officer do produce all relevant documents or authenticated copies of documents pursuant to the Letter of Request to be marked in numerical order as the Defendant's exhibits. The term "documents" as used here means all hand-written, typed, printed and photostated matter and drafts, duplicates, carbon copies, thermofax copies, Xerox copies, photostatic copies and other copies thereon.

4. That the Clerk of Court or said Examiner herein do take down or cause to be taken down in writing the evidence of the witness in examination, or cross-examination and re-examination in accordance with Order 39 of the Grand Court Rules; or in the form of a sworn Affidavit provided that there is no party who wishes to conduct any cross-examination and/or re-examination of the witness and further do require the witness to sign his deposition in the said Examiner's presence and when so completed file them with the Clerk of the Grand Court to be forwarded to Judge Jose Benquis Camhi as set out in the Letter of Request; or alternatively that the Clerk of the Court have the witness swear his Affidavit with the attached exhibits before the Clerk of the Court and in her presence and when so completed have the sworn Affidavit with the exhibits forwarded to Judge Jose Benquis Camhi as set out in the Letter of Request.



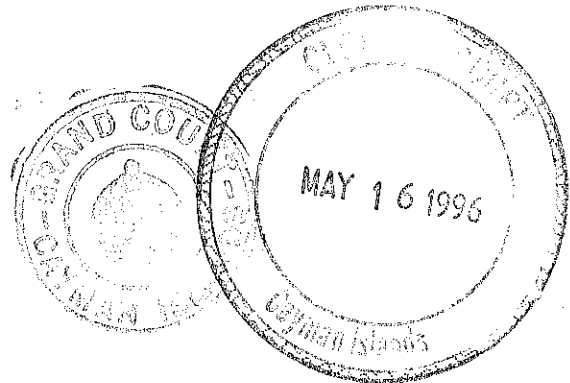
5. That there be liberty to apply for such further and other directions as to the conduct of this matter as this Honourable Court deems fit to impose.
