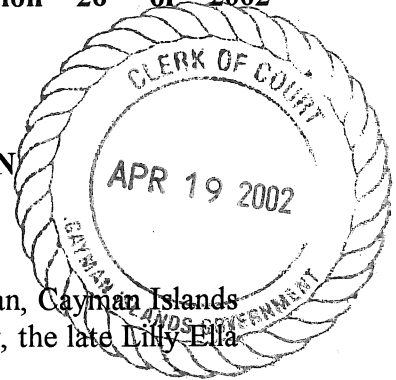



I declare myself (and my successors) to be jointly and severally bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Islands in the sum of CI\$70,000.00.

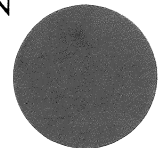



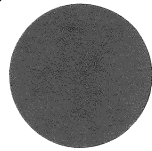
BOND OF SURETIES
