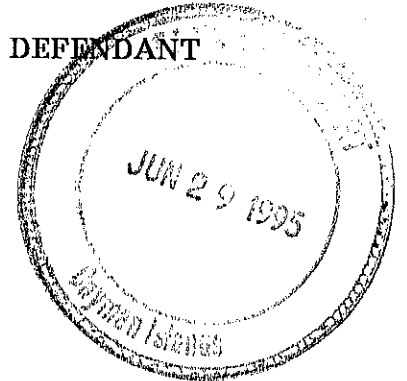

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the abovenamed Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within (14 days) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

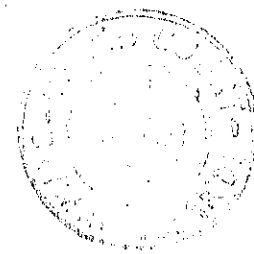

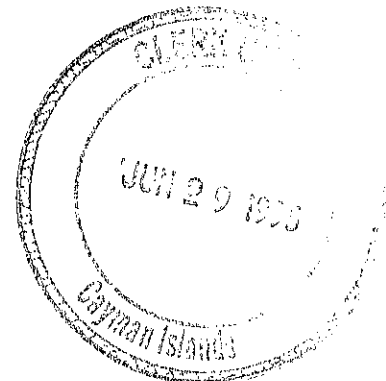
STATEMENT OF CLAIM




1. At all material times, the Plaintiff was a Shipping Company registered in Grand Cayman and the Defendant was a Business Man resident in Grand Cayman.
2. On the 29th day of July, 1994, the Defendant drew a cheque for CI \$3,582.13 upon Bank of Butterfield, payable to the Plaintiff for shipping services provided by the Plaintiff.
3. The Plaintiff duly presented the said cheque for payment on the 3rd day of August, 1994, but it was dishonoured.
4. By a letter dated the 2nd day of December, 1994 the Plaintiff duly gave notice to the Defendant of the said dishonour.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The said sum of CI \$3,587.13.
2. Interest at the prescribed rate of 8 3/8% from the 3rd day of August 1994, to the date hereof being CI \$271.13 and accruing daily thereafter in the amount of CI \$0.88.
3. Costs and Attorneys fees totalling CI \$380.00.



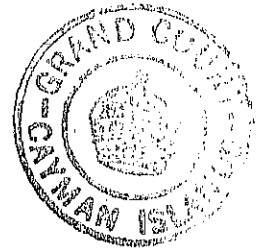

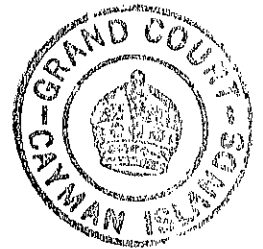
Notes on address for service
