

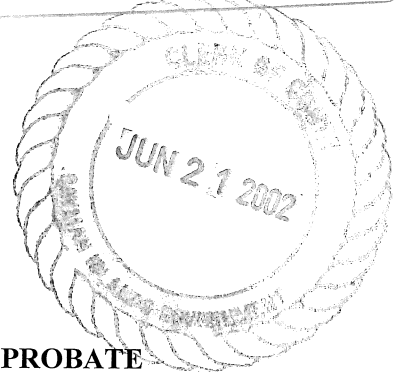

**APPLICATION FOR RESEALING GRANT OF PROBATE**

Succession Law, Section 23 (1)

We, Helen E. Kuzniak and Lorne Hanson of Calgary, Alberta, Canada, are the joint Personal Representatives appointed by the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta (Surrogate Matter) Judicial District of Calgary of the estate of the late Robert Kolstad, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Grant of Probate was made on the 14th day of December 2001, and the said Grant of Probate with the Will annexed, together with the Certificate of Death, annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for Resealing of the Grant of Probate of the estate of Robert Kolstad and enclose our Affidavit in that behalf and undertake that in the event of a Resealed Grant being made to us:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Grant of Probate, we will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such Resealed Grant to us, we will administer the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands according to the directions, if any, of the Court and will file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.

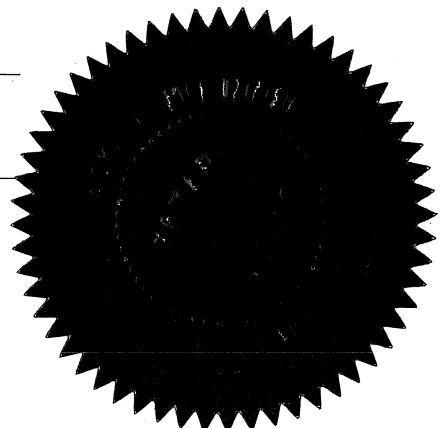
