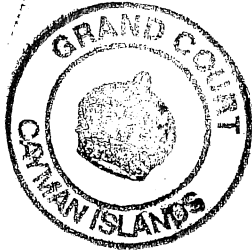


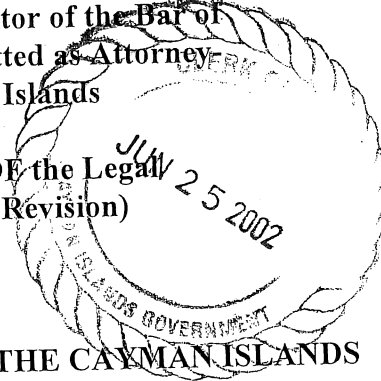




TO: HIS LORDSHIP THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS
