LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (STUDENTS) REGULATIONS (2000 Revision)

Application to be Admitted as an Attorney-at-Law

(Section 3 (1) (c) and Regulation 15(2))

We, Delene Cacho and Valdis Foldats, being at varying times during the period of Articles, Clerk of the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands, and Terrence Maureen Caudeiron, also of the Cayman Islands Judicial Department do solemnly and sincerely declare as follows –

A. And I the said Terrence Maureen Caudeiron for myself do say that –


- (1) I am one and the same person named as clerk in the Articles of Clerkship bearing the date the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2000 now produced and shown to me marked with the letter “A”.
- (2) The said Articles of Clerkship were registered pursuant to Regulation 16 on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2001, commencing on the 19<sup>th</sup> November 2000.
- (3) Since the day of execution of the Articles I have been actually employed in the proper business practice and employment of the Judicial Department and have not held any other office or engaged in any other employment during that period.

- (5) I was awarded the Attorney-at-Law Certificate on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2000, and a true copy of the same is now produced and shown to me marked with the letter “B”.


B. And We, Delene Cacho and Valdis Foldats the said Clerk(s) of the Court for ourselves do say –


- (1) We are qualified under section 15 of the Legal Practitioners Law (1995 Revision) to take a person into our service as an Articled Clerk, and are the same persons named as principal(s) in the Articles of Clerkship now produced and shown to us marked with the letter “A”.
- (2) The said Terrence Maureen Caudeiron has been bound by Articles to the Clerk of Court since the 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 2000, and has since that date been actually employed by the Judicial Department as an Articled Clerk.
- (3) The period of articles which has been served satisfies the requirement of Regulation 17.

(4) The said Terrence Maureen Caudeiron is a fit and proper person to be admitted as an Attorney-at-Law.
