ORIGINATING SUMMONS



1. That the Applicant be granted custody, care and control of the minor child Rhiannon Emily Peggy Day with reasonable access to be afforded to the Respondent on such terms as this Honourable Court deems fit, .

2. That there be such further Orders as the Court deems just and equitable in the circumstances.

LET THE RESPONDENT within 14 days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office.
