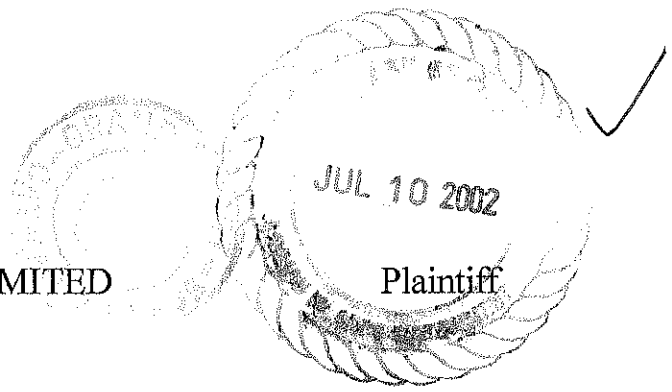

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above named Plaintiff in respect of claim set out in the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days of service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P. O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 10th July, 2002.

NOTE: This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, within 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by the order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is a locally registered company with a licence to sell plumbing material.
2. The defendant is a plumbing contractor who lives at house no. 132 in Savannah.
3. Sometime in about 1992 the defendant entered into an agreement with the plaintiff whereby it was agreed that the defendant would obtain goods on credit from the plaintiff for which he would pay on a monthly installment.
4. On 1st June, 2001 the defendant's balance amounted to \$13,604.50. The plaintiff informed the defendant that his credit would cease until he had cleared off the balance. As a result, the defendant ceased buying from the plaintiff and has paid only \$6,000.00 (1st June, \$1000.00; 13th July, \$2000.00; 7th September, \$1000.00; 19th October, \$1000.00 and 15th February, 2002 \$1000.00) towards the bill, his last payment being \$1000.00 on the 15th February, 2001 leaving a balance of **\$7,604.50** due and owing.

In addition to the principal sum of **\$7,604.50** due to the plaintiff, it is entitled to interest at the statutory rate. Interest of **\$544.52** on the principal sum is also due as of the date of the issuance of these proceedings. The particulars of interest are set out in the schedule attached to the Statement of Claim.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays that the defendant be ordered to pay:

1. Principal sum = \$7,604.50
2. Calculated interest = \$544.52
4. Further interest at 4.5% per annum from 10th July, 2002 until payment.
3. Costs to be taxed or agreed

INDORSEMENT

The amount claimed in respect of the debt is \$7,604.50 principal and \$544.52 as interest until the issue of the Writ of Summons for a total of **\$8,149.02**. The amount of fixed costs is \$250.00 and the cost of issuing this Writ of Summons is \$150.00. If within the time for returning the acknowledgement of service the defendants pay the plaintiff's attorneys-at-law the total amount claimed in principal and interest, the fixed costs of issuing of the Writ of Summons, further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the plaintiff's attorneys-at-law at the NevLaw Building, 180 Shedden Road.
