ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT, MARITA HOLDINGS LDC (IN VOLUNTARY LIQUIDATION), whose registered office is situate at P O Box 714GT, 2nd Floor, Anderson Square Building, George Town, Grand Cayman, BWI, attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 11 day of OCT 2002 at 9:30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiffs, Erika Von Der Goltz of 15 Calle 2-36, Zona 10 Guatemala and Dresdner Bank Lateinamerika AG of P O Box 714GT, 2nd Floor, Anderson Square Building, George Town, Grand Cayman, BWI, for the following:

1. A Declaration that the transfer on 7 May 2001 of the 2 bearer shares in Marita Holdings LDC (in voluntary liquidation) ("the Company") to Dresdner Bank Lateinamerika AG ("the Bank") was a valid transfer of shares in the Company and that the Bank is and has been since 7 May 2001 the holder of those shares in the Company.
2. The voluntary winding up and dissolution of the Company which has occurred as a result of Section 200(1)(c) of the Companies Law (2002 Revision) ("the Law") be stayed altogether pursuant to Section 141 of the Law.
3. The Liquidator do vacate office forthwith.
4. Further or other relief.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Originating Summons on it counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands BWI.
