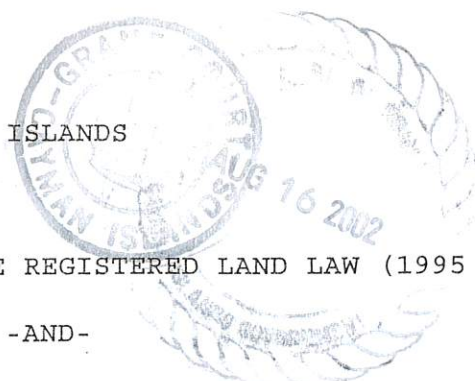

NOTICE OF ORIGINATING MOTION

TAKE NOTICE that the Court at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman will be moved on the 4 day of OCT at 9:30 a.m./p.m. or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, by counsel on behalf of Henry E. Bodden, Jr. for an order that the Court grant leave, pursuant to Order 3 Rule 5, for this appeal to be entered notwithstanding that more than twenty-eight (28) days have elapsed since the date of the decision of the Registrar of Lands made on the 13th December 1999 as required by Order 55 Rule 4

AND for an order that the restrictions on Registration Section Lower Valley Block 32B Parcel 9 and on Registration Section Lower Valley Block 32C Parcel 39 be removed

AND for an order that the costs of and incidental to this appeal may be paid by Paul Andrew Bodden Sr.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this appeal are:-

the restrictions were placed on the parcels on the strength of affidavit evidence of Michael Bodden and Frank Bodden to the effect that, in their opinion, Paul Bodden had paid for part of the share currently registered in the Applicant's name so as to raise doubts as to the accuracy of the shareholdings as currently recorded. Although Paul Bodden claims to have a valid receipt for such purchase, the Applicant has asked him on numerous occasions to produce it and he has failed to do so. The Applicant is now able to provide new affidavit evidence which discredits the affidavit evidence of Michael Bodden and Frank Bodden to the extent that the restrictions should be removed.
