APPLICATION FOR RESEALING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

Succession Law, Section 23 (1)

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Notarial Record (Letters of Administration), we will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such Resealed Grant to us, we will administer the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands according to the directions, if any, of the Court and will file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
