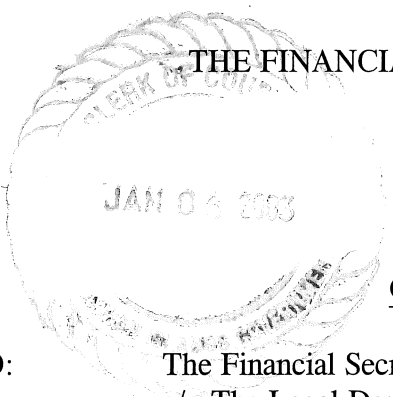



By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Luis Pablo Bustamante D., of Priv. San Isidro 44, Colonia Reforma Social, 11650 Mexico, the Plaintiff seeks:

- (1) an order that BEDE Ltd. (the "Company") be restored to the register of companies; and
