

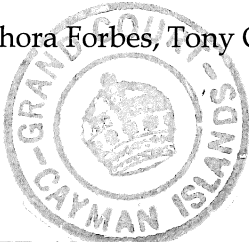

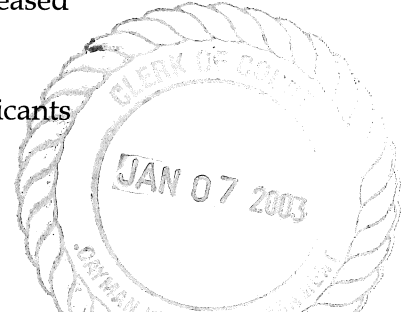


EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS
