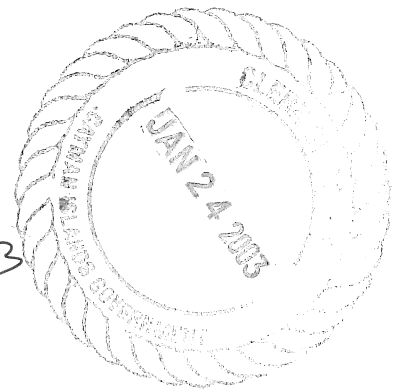

**(Succession Law. Section (3))**


