THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Company incorporated pursuant to the laws of the Cayman Islands and has its Registered Office at PO Box 31666 SMB, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands. It carries on business as a construction contractor.
2. The Defendant, Edlin Myles, is an individual residing in the Cayman Islands and carries on business as a developer, among other things.
3. Between June 2001 and September 2001, the Plaintiff provided construction services to the Defendant with respect to a project called West Point Town Homes.
4. The Plaintiff completed all work requested and provided invoices to the Defendant as follows:

5. The Defendant from time to time made payments totalling \$10,400 and there remains outstanding a principal sum of \$8,903.43, exclusive of interest and costs.
6. Despite numerous requests for full payment, the sum of \$8,903.43 remains due and owing to the Plaintiff. The Plaintiff also claims interest pursuant to the Judicature Law and the Judgment Debts (Rates of Interest) Rules as amended from time to time from the date of the rendering of each invoice as indicated above. Interest as of the date of the issuance of this proceeding is CI\$722.28, which sum accrues at the daily rate of CI\$1.10.
7. The Plaintiff also claims costs as a result of the Defendant's failure to pay the above stated sums.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS

- a) Principal debt of \$8903.43;
- b) Pre- and post-judgment interest of \$722.28 to the date of the issuance of these proceedings;

- c) Pre- and post-judgment interest from 7 February 2003;
- d) Costs.

INDORSEMENT

The principal amount claimed in respect of the debt is CI\$8,903.43 plus CI\$722.28 for interest. The amount of the filing fees to commence the proceeding is CI\$150.00. If, within the time for returning the acknowledgement of service, the defendant pays the plaintiff or its attorneys-at-law the total amount claimed in principal, interest, and costs, further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or to its attorneys-at-law.

INDORSEMENT REGARDING INTEREST

(Order 6 (2)(e) of the Grand Court Rules)

- i. The contractual term upon which interest is claimed in accordance with the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) and the Judgment Debt (Rates of Interest) Rules as amended from time to time.
- ii. The prescribed rate of interest during the entire relevant s:
 - a. From 22 June 2001 to 30 November 2001 was 6.25%
 - b. From 1 December 2001 to 06 February 2003 was 4.50 %.
- iii. The total interest claimed as at the date of the issue of the writ of summons (6 February 2003) is CI\$722.28.
- iv. The amount of interest accruing each day following the issue of the writ of summons is CI\$1.10

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF WRIT OF SUMMONS**

1. The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of each Defendant or by each Defendant if acting in person.

After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

2. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings *must also serve a defence* on the Attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person).

If a Statement of Claim is indorsed on the Writ (i.e. the words "Statement of Claim" appear on the top of page 2), the Defence must be served within 14 days after the time for acknowledging service of the Writ, unless in the meantime a summons for judgment is served on the Defendant.

If the Statement of Claim is not indorsed on the Writ, the Defence need not be served until 14 days after a Statement of Claim has been served on the Defendant.

If the Defendant fails to serve his defence within the appropriate time, the Plaintiff may enter judgment against him without further notice.

3. A *Stay of Execution* against the Defendant's goods may be applied for where the Defendant is unable to pay the money for which any judgment is entered. If A Defendant to an action for a debt or liquidated demand (i.e. a fixed sum) who does not intend to contest the proceedings states, in answer to Question 3 in the Acknowledgment of Service, that he intends to apply for a stay, execution will be stayed for 14 days after his Acknowledgment, but he must, within that time, *issue a Summons* for a stay of execution, supported by an affidavit of his means. The affidavit should state any offer which the Defendant desires to make for payment of the money by instalments or otherwise.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the name stated on the Writ of Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.
