Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

The Plaintiff's claim is for:

1. The sum of US\$34,906.48 (CI\$28,623.31) being the sum due pursuant to a contract and policy of insurance issued by or assigned to the Defendant dated 15 March 1991 in respect of a claim for medical expenses incurred by the Plaintiff insured in Panama between or about 27 October 2000 and 30 November 2000; and
2. Interest on the said amount pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the prescribed rates being:
 - (1) From 1 December 2000 to the date hereof the sum of US\$4,662.96
 - (2) From the date hereof the daily rate of US\$4.30, or such other rate as may be prescribed
3. Costs

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of US\$39,569.44 (including interest) and CI\$500.00 costs further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or its Attorney.
