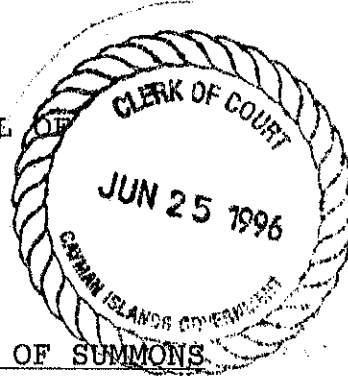

WRIT OF SUMMONS.



TO: The Attorney General of the Cayman Islands,
Attorney Generals Chambers
Grand Cayman

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P O Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 19th day of March 1996.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM



AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

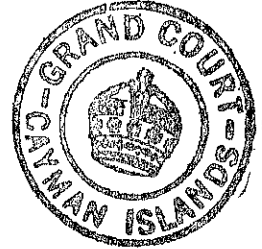
1. The Plaintiff was at all material times a tailor and operator on a visit to the Cayman Islands from Jamaica.
2. The Respondent is the Attorney General of the Cayman Islands.
3. On or about 6th March 1995, the Plaintiff arrived in Cayman at Owen Roberts Airport at about 1.30am.
4. The Plaintiff carried among other things 1 bottle of Napoleon brandy and 1 bottle of Ellvin Tonic. At Owen Roberts Airport the Plaintiff was arrested; detained by the Cayman Islands customs for carrying illegal drugs in the said bottles of brandy and tonic.
5. On or about the 9th March 1995, the Plaintiff was taken before the Summary Court, by the said Customs officer, on a charge of possession of illegal drugs, with intent to supply, and importation. The Plaintiff was remanded in the custody of the Cayman Islands police without bail until on or about 16th March 1995.
6. On or about 16th March 1995, the Plaintiff was again taken to the Summary Court, by the said Customs officer, where the Plaintiff was again remanded in the custody of the Cayman Islands police.
7. On or about the 20th March 1995, the Plaintiff was taken before the Summary Court by the said Customs officer, where the charges of possession of illegal drug with intent to supply and importation were withdrawn against the Plaintiff. The Plaintiff was subsequently released from custody and imprisonment by the said Customs officer.
8. The Plaintiff's said arrest, imprisonment charge and remand were committed and procured by the Defendant, by his servants and, or, agents.
9. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Plaintiff was wrongfully arrested, wrongfully imprisoned and or wrongfully detained by the Defendant, his servants and or agents, thereby the Plaintiff suffered loss and damage.

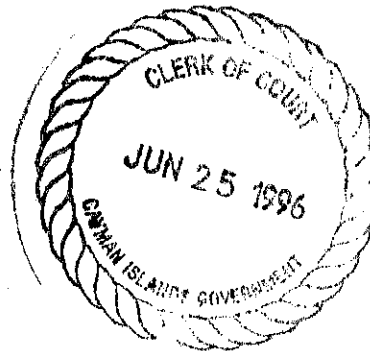
